Chapter cannot host any non-alcoholic event outside the Columbia City limits during the Fall 2011 semester. • <u>Risk Management Meetings</u>: chapter social chair must meet with the IFC VP of Risk Management at least three times throughout the Fall 2011 semester to plan for event safety. • <u>Risk Management Presentation</u>: must organize a presentation facilitated by a member of the Columbia Police Department. Attendance: 80% of chapter. • <u>Monthly Meetings with Greek Life</u>: must work with Office of Greek Life to meet monthly with chapter's Greek Life point person. • <u>Educational Presentations</u>: must organize a presentation facilitated by the Office of Greek Life discussing University, IFC, and TKE national policies. A second presentation must be facilitated by a representative of TKE national headquarters. Attendance for both presentations: 80% of chapter. • <u>Chapter Membership Review</u>: it is strongly recommended that chapter alumni, working with the chapter leadership engage in a full membership review.
